

Internet (via WAP)

This insert replaces the 'Internet' Chapter in your User Guide, it enables you to benefit from the latest WAP (Wireless Application Protocol) developments.

Introduction

Your phone is able to access Internet, enabling browsing and interaction with services. Owing to the smaller display size, the Internet pages require specially formatting for mobile phone use, hence not all services will be available. Please check via standard Internet or your Service Provider regarding current availability of WAP (mobile phone) format services.

It may be necessary to register with your Service Provider for Internet access, please check.

Setup

It is likely that your Service Provider will have already set your Internet Access Profile(s). If not, you need to obtain this information from your Service Provider, and set it, selecting Profiles from your Browser Menu.

Using right Softkey

Your right softkey can offer up to three functions. The right end of the softkey enables you to scroll through these functions.



Press to see next function.



Press to select.

Examples of functions :



Jump to an Internet page (online).



Select from list.



Select sub Menu.



Select Browser Menu.

Access to Internet

Menu → Office & Fun → Internet

Allow some seconds for connection, your first connection will display a list from which you can choose (as below).

Subsequently the last used page will be displayed:



Scroll and select with **0**, or use number keys.



Press.

Please note : when on line additional costs may be incurred (see Disconnect time).

Online, Offline

Connection symbols (top right).




You can press repeatedly to maximize display, losing headings, softkey labels, etc. and return.

Internet (via WAP)

Browser Menu



Press until  shows.



Open Browser menu.

Homepage

Provides direct access to your Homepage (this may be set by your Service Provider).

Favourites

You can set up to nine pages for quickest access.

To set or change :

Highlight an entry (eg Empty)



Press until



shows, and select.

Select, and enter your page heading.

Then enter the URL address following http:// prompt.

Navigation

Goto URL

This displays http:// prefix, enter remaining Internet address for direct access.

Show URL

This displays Internet address (URL = Uniform Resource Locator).

Reset Browser

This resets your Browser, deleting the last pages accessed.

Profiles

Up to 5 Access Profiles can be set, depending on Service Provider (see next page).

Services

Channels

You can save Internet pages, and then use them offline.

Outbox

You can save text (eg E-Mails), retrieve, edit and send them later, depending on Service Provider).

About

This displays the Browser version.



This ends connection to Internet.

Special characters for Internet (see also messaging)



press 3 times /




press 3 times @



press 4 times . (dot)

http://


Write http then press .


Internet (via WAP)

Profiles

It is likely that your Service Provider will have set one or more Internet Access Profiles. If not you must obtain the necessary input from them and set this yourself. Subject to your Service Provider you may set, or change up to 5 Internet Access Profiles.


Setting new Profiles


 Open Browser Menu.

Profiles Scroll and select with .

Profile 1-5 Select a Profile.

Profile Settings Select.

Select as required from the following settings, confirming with . Then :

 Press briefly to step back to Profiles menu.

Activate ProfileSelect, see below.

Profile Name

You can provide your own name for the Profile.

Dial Up Number

Enter the supplied number.

Connection Type

Select either ISDN (V.110) or Analogue (V.32).

Login Name

Enter your supplied Login Name.

Password

Enter your Password.

IP Address

Enter your IP (Internet Protocol) address.

IP Port

Enter your Gateway.

Homepage

Enter your Homepage, see also Navigation in your Browser Menu.

Disconnect Time

You may set the Time out period, in seconds, when you will be disconnected after your last keypress. The following list of settings require inputs.

Activate

It is necessary to activate profiles after you have set them, please see above.

* Indicates an activated profile.

Encryption

Some services may require encryption to enhance security.

Verify Key

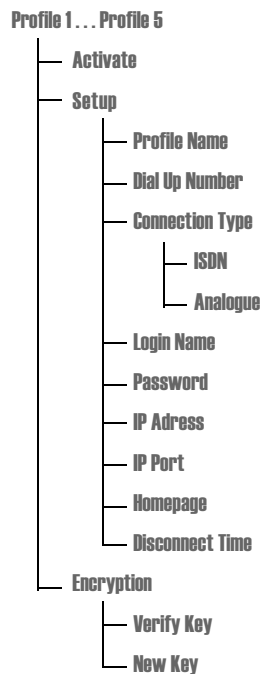
You can check encryption status.

New Key

You can request a new encryption key from your Service Provider.
